The Hawaii State Department of Education is proud to support the Hawaii School Counselor Association (HSCA) in their efforts to provide ongoing professional development for school counselors. Toward this end, we are pleased to announce the 2015 HSCA Conference scheduled for Friday, February 6, 2015, from 7:45 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. at the Hawaii Prince Hotel Waikiki, 100 Holomana Street, Honolulu, HI 96815.

The conference theme is "**Mind, Body, and Soul: Preparing Students and Counselors for College and Career Readiness**".

The keynote speaker will be Dr. Trish Hatch, Director of the School Counseling Program and Associate Professor at San Diego State University (SDSU). She also serves as the Executive Director of the Center for Excellence in School Counseling and Leadership (CESCAL), in the College of Education at SDSU and is the co-author of the original ASCA model and the author of "The Use of Data in School Counseling." Dr. Hatch will be presenting on school counselors and their roles as advocates for students. She will also share passionate stories using data to show how school counselors make a difference in the lives of students each day. Dr. Hatch strives to help school counselors gather "social capital," which occurs when principals and administrators recognize that their schools – and students – cannot function without school counselors.

Following the keynote presentation, there will be three rounds of breakout sessions. The sessions will provide school counselors with assessment practices and interventions and strategies to use to enhance their school counseling programs.

The registration fee is \$70 for HSCA members and \$95 for non-members, and must be **received** by **Wednesday, January 21, 2014**. Payment instructions are included on the registration form.

Hawaii P-20 is offering scholarships to cover registration fees for secondary school counselors from Title I schools. If you are from a Title I school and are a school counselor from a middle, intermediate or high school, and are interested in receiving a scholarship, please check off the box on the registration form. Scholarships are limited and available on a first-come, first-served basis. Participants requesting scholarships **MUST** submit their registration **via FAX by 4 p.m. on Friday, January 9, 2015**.

Neighbor island secondary school counselors from Title I schools may also apply for travel scholarships, sponsored by Hawaii P-20, to cover their travel (air and car) by visiting the HSCA website at [www.hawaiisca.org](http://www.hawaiisca.org). Scholarships have specific requirements and applications must be submitted **via FAX by 4 p.m. on Friday, January 9, 2015**. Preference will be given to first time attendees.
