The Hawaii State Department of Education is proud to support the Hawaii School Counselor Association (HSCA) in their efforts to provide ongoing professional development for school counselors. Toward this end, we are pleased to announce the 2018 HSCA Mini-Conference scheduled for Friday, February 9, 2018, from 7:45 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. at the Hawaii Okinawa Center, 94-587 Uke'e Street, Waipahu, HI 96797.

The conference theme is "**Recharge, Relate, Reflect, Realize: Being the Best for our Students for Social and Academic Success!**"

The keynote speaker will be Dr. Terrance Scott, from the University of Louisville in Kentucky. Dr. Scott is a Professor and Distinguished University Scholar in the College of Education and Human Development, and his methods of intervention demonstrate he is a true behaviorist – working with many different effective strategies to shape students' behaviors. His message will inspire and remind you why School Counselors are so vital in the school system. His story is accompanied by evidenced based strategies that are easy for you to take back and use in your school.

The registration fee is \$55 for HSCA members and \$85 for non-members, and must be **received by Wednesday, January 24, 2018**. Payment and registration instructions are included on the registration form.
