SUBJECT: **August 2019 Professional Development Opportunity**

The Hawaii School Counselor Association (HSCA) is proud to offer a professional development opportunity for School Counselors and Interested Providers. This opportunity is scheduled for Wednesday, August 14, and Thursday, August 15, 2019, and will be held at the Mana Christian Ohana, 67-1182 Lindsey Road, Waimea, Hawaii 96743 (Big Island).

The keynote speaker will be Dr. Terrance Scott, from the University of Louisville in Kentucky. Dr. Scott is a Professor and Distinguished University Scholar in the College of Education and Human Development, and his methods of intervention demonstrate he is a true behaviorist – working with many different effective strategies to shape students' behaviors. Dr. Scott will be presenting the following topics:

*Essential Features and Considerations for Leading Small Group Social Skills Instruction K-12*

This full-day workshop will lead participants through a step-by-step process for planning, managing, and teaching small group social skills instruction. Examples of specific lessons will be provided and broken into small components for deeper discussion. Considerations at each still will be discussed with activities and videos to facilitate engagement and mastery of content.

*Prevention and Response Strategies for Students with Escalating Misbehavior in the School*

This full-day workshop will focus first on prevention of the most typical student misbehaviors using a range of instructional, environmental, and relationship strategies. However, because these strategies will not be effective in every case, strategies for effective responses to behaviors such as non-compliance, disruption, disrespect, verbal aggression, and provocation. Video scenarios will be used to engage participants in discussions how responses may need to vary across different types of students.

The registration fee for both days is \$70. The first 100 DOE registrants will be free (must register via PDE3). Registration for non-DOE attendees (and any registrants after the 100 enrollees) is \$70 per person.
